In the heart of Dalmatia, 25 km from Split and Makarska, lies Omiš, a small town with a great pirate past. Situated at the estuary of the River Cetina, under the cliffs of Mosor and Omiš Dinara, apart from its Mediterranean charm, Omiš always enchants visitors with the continental spirit that the Cetina brings with it. The trademark of Omiš is the Dalmatian textiles and clothing factory 'Galeb', established in 1951 and today one of the most significant underwear manufacturers in Croatia. Besides a sightseeing tour of Omiš and its surrounding area, enjoy visiting Klis which boasts a fortress, a symbol of Croatian resistance at the time of the Turks, as well as Split and Trogir, towns rich in history. You will be delighted with Šibenik and its cathedral, a pinnacle of Renaissance architecture, and in Krka National Park you will experience the incredible grandeur of nature. The combination of a green-blue experience, the beautiful river landscapes and accommodation on a sandy beach, together with the cultural heritage and fun, will certainly not leave anyone disappointed. Do not miss it!

The activity programme for a 4 day package includes: Day 1: Omiš; Day 2: Cetina canyon - Radman's Mills; Day 3: Šibenik - Krka National Park; Day 4: Klis - Split - Trogir. Packages are available from 1 February - 27 May and from 24 September - 30 November, for groups of between 2 - 50 people. Accommodation is provided at mobile homes directly on the sandy beach in a Galeb campsite. Transport is possible with your own vehicle or provided by us.
